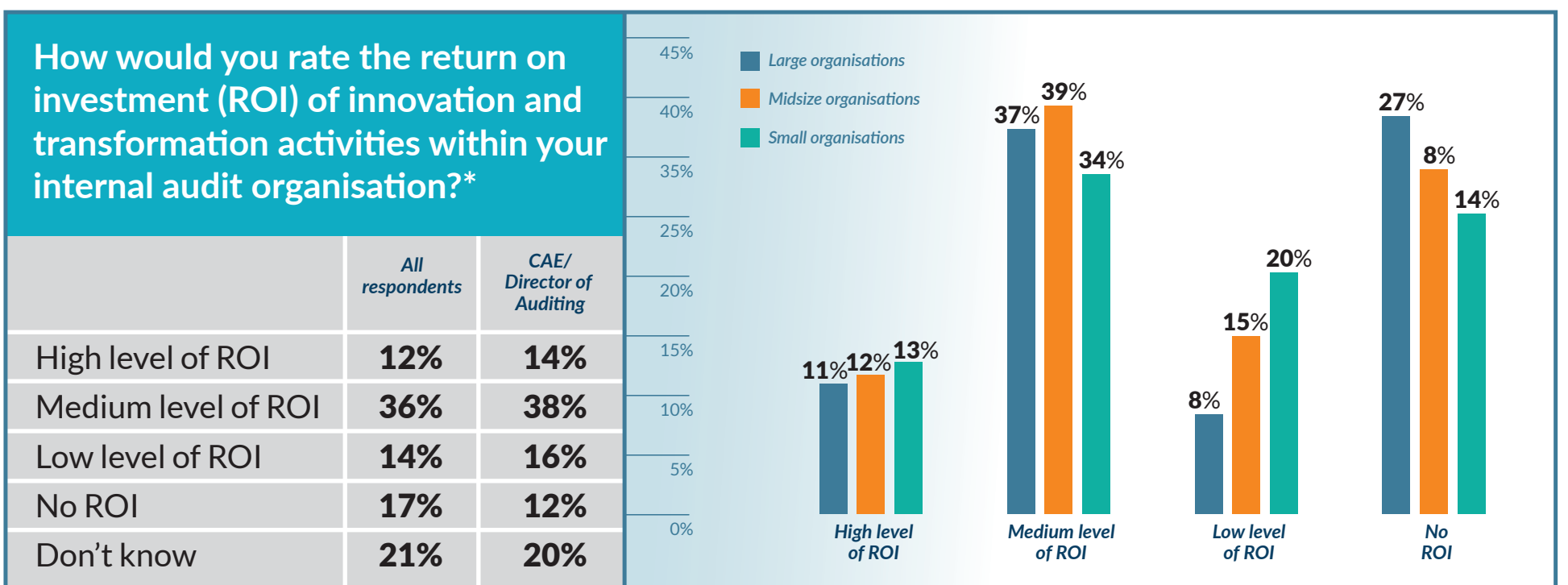
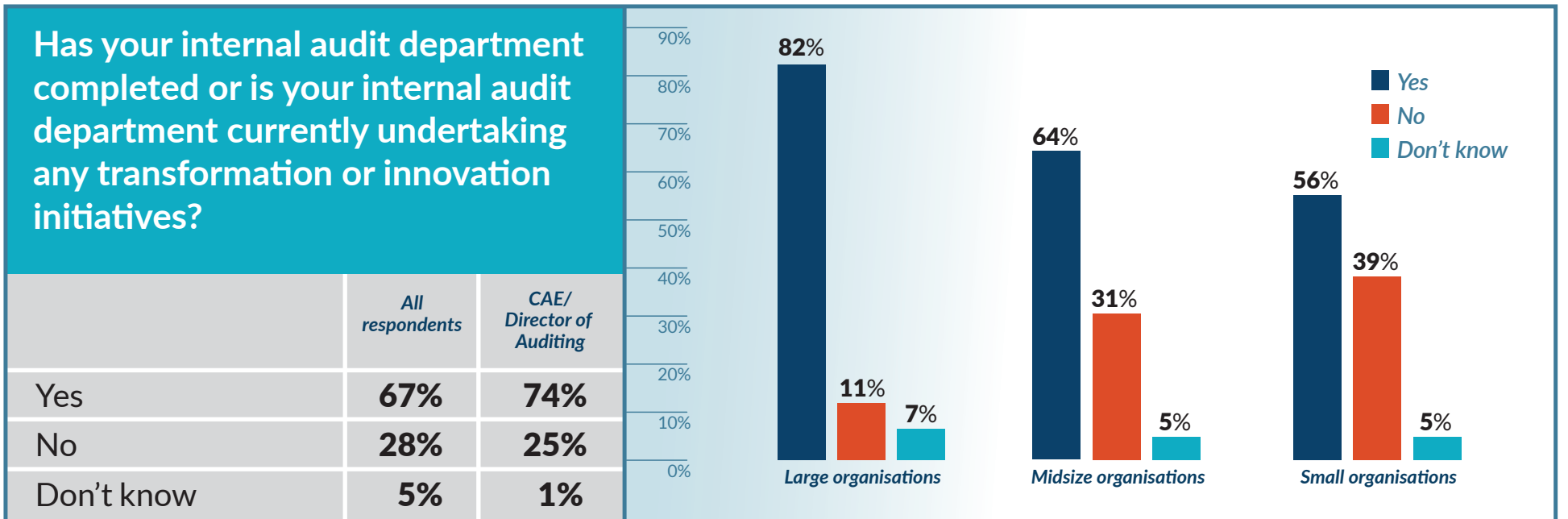


Innovation and Transformation Are Driving the Future of Internal Auditing

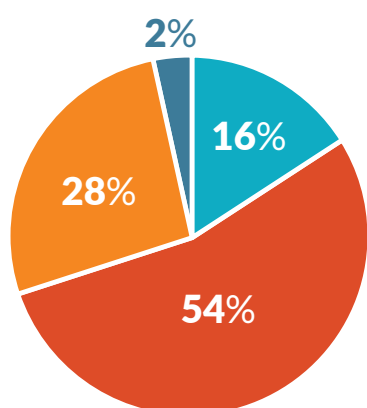
